Meet with your High School Counselor!					
Discuss what opportunities may be available to you for dual or concurrent credit and find out if they have any specific dates, deadlines, or procedures you need to follow in addition to Collin College's.					
Apply at applytexas.org (New Students) □ Double check you are applying for the correct term and that you fully submit your application. □ Please allow 2-3 business days for your application to be processed.					
Set up OneLogin (New Students) ☐ You'll receive your OneLogin username and temporary password via helpdesk@collin.edu ☐ Tip: Set up OneLogin on your phone or on a device that you will always have access to. ☐ Click on the Workday app in the OneLogin portal ☐ Please review your customized list of registration requirements through Workday Tasks.					
Complete the Mandatory Campus Safety Training (New Students) An hour after completing in Workday, the action item should be removed. If it has not been removed from your account, please email admissions@collin.edu with your CWID and a screenshot showing completion of the Campus Safety Training.					
Complete Dual Credit Permission Form with your High School Counselor (Every Semester) Review the online schedule (once published) and course descriptions (anytime) for available courses (more information about dual credit eligible courses on page 2) Reach out to a Special Admissions Coordinator or dualcredit@collin.edu if you need advising Your high school counselor must email or turn the form in directly to the Dual Credit Office					
 TSIA2 New dual credit students are considered non-degree seeking and are automatically exempt from the TSI until they have earned 15 credit hours and will work with dualcredit@collin.edu to apply their exemption to their account. DC students who have earned 15 credit hours are considered degree seeking and are required to take the TSIA2 or provide proof of exemption if they have not already taken a college level course in ELAR and/or MATH. More information on the TSIA2 and exemptions can be found on page 2. 					
Bacterial Meningitis Vaccine (Only for students taking courses on a Collin Campus) □ Students taking courses on a Collin campus will need to provide a valid bacterial meningitis vaccine record (vaccine administered within 5 years of start of classes) or exemption prior to registration and in accordance with your high school's deadlines. □ More information available online at https://www.collin.edu/admissions/meningitis/					
Registration (Completed by student) All registration will be done online through Workday In Workday, go to your "Academics Hub" On the left side under "Planning and Registration" click on "Find Course Sections" Use the search features to find courses that work for you, you can register for one course at a time or build a saved schedule and register from your saved schedule If you have trouble registering for a course, reach out to dualcredit@collin.edu for assistance
